Adopted 16 February 2017


Whereas, MSU has a strong relationship with local breweries and has supported responsible alcohol production through several programs within the College of Agriculture and a “Hops and History” lecture series at the Museum of the Rockies; and,

Whereas, Local breweries are popular with students as locations to socialize and responsibly drink alcohol after classes and on weekends; and,

Whereas, MSU has a liberal alcohol education program that focuses on responsible alcohol consumption; and,

Whereas, Expanding the licensing policy to allow alcoholic products could create additional revenue for MSU and its students; now, therefore, be it,

Resolved, That the Associated Students of Montana State University supports expanding the MSU licensing policy to allow university trademarks on alcoholic products only for the 125th centennial celebration.
